### **ALL BREEDING ESTABLISHMENTS**

### **RWITC LTD. 2020 Annual Auction Sale**

- 1. The RWITC Ltd 2020 Annual Auction Sale will be conducted in Mumbai on **03 Feb 2020** and **04 Feb 2020**.
- 2. The Letter Inviting Entries and Conditions of Sale for the RWITC Ltd 2020 Annual Auction Sale are available on <a href="http://www.indianstudbook.com/latest-news/2019/08/06/rwitc-ltd.-annual-auction-sale---2020">http://www.indianstudbook.com/latest-news/2019/08/06/rwitc-ltd.-annual-auction-sale---2020</a>
- 3. The Salient points of the Sale are as under :-
  - (a) Date of the Sale Monday, **03 Feb 2020** and Tuesday, **04 Feb 2020**.
  - (b) Horses would be allowed to enter the sale stables from **27 Jan 2020** onwards.
  - (c) Dr Hasneyn Mirza will be visiting all breeding establishments in **Sep 2019**.
  - (d) Entry fee Rs. 10,000/- per lot + GST @ 18% or applicable rate.
  - (e) Entries to close on 07 Nov 2019.
  - (f) Late Entries. Entries received after 5.30 p.m. on 07 Nov 2019 up to 5.30 p.m. on 01 Dec 2019 Rs. 25,000/- per lot + GST @ 18%. (i.e. till the catalogue goes to Press).
  - (g) Entries Received after 01 Dec 2019. Late entry directly to the Blue Page Section since qualified subsequently Rs. 35,000/- per lot + GST @ 18%.
  - (h) **Wild Card Entries**. Lots entered for the Sale earlier (but not in the Blue Page Section) and later the Vendor decides to add it to the Blue Page Section (the horse might have been eligible for Blue Page Section at the time of entry or subsequently) Rs. 5,000/-. Such lots will be sold in the Blue Page Section on Day 1 of the Sale.

(i) ONLY APPROVED OWNERS TO BID. Only persons who are approved Owners of horses i.e persons approved by a race club to own and run racehorses shall be permitted to bid at the said Sale. All approved owners shall remit 10% of the purchase price immediately. The balance amount of the purchase price must be remitted to RWITC within 03 (three) days of the conclusion of the said Sale. If the purchaser/s do not remit the balance amount within 03 days of the conclusion of the said Sale, the initial amount of 10% remitted by the purchaser/s shall stand forfeited by RWITC without any further notice to the purchaser/s and further, the said Sale shall be deemed to have stood cancelled automatically on the expiry of the aforesaid 3 (three) days period and the Lot shall be returned to the Vendor. In addition, the purchaser/s who default in payment will immediately be placed on the Unpaid Forfeit List with all attendant consequences as per the Rules of the Racing of RWITC Ltd.

## **Covering Certificates - 2019**

4. Reference Para 53(a)(i) of the Rules and Requirements for Registration of Thoroughbred and Half-bred Horses in India - effective from 1 Dec 2014. Covering Certificates for the period 01 Feb to 31 Jul 2019 may be processed without any fee, provided they are submitted on-line by **31 Aug 2019**.

#### **List Of Stock Sheltered**

- 5. Reference Para 87 of Rules and Requirements for Registration of Thoroughbred and Half-bred Horses in India effective from 1 Dec 2014.
- 6. A list of stock sheltered at each Breeding Establishment as on **01 Sep 2019** is due to be received by **30 Sep 2019**. All Breeding Establishments are requested to take note of the same.
- 7. Details of stock as per records of the Stud Book Authority of India may be viewed by Breeding Establishments using the online portal. Amendments required to the list may be informed to us via email.

## Passports - Foals of 2018

8. Passports of **393** foals of 2018 are being despatched to various Breeding Establishments. All concerned are required to kindly identify the yearlings with the corresponding passports and revert to us in case any discrepancies are noticed.

11. At the request of **Dr. S. M. Karthikeyan, Chairman, Veterinary Commission**, given below is the region wise allocation of Breeding Establishments for collection of Blood samples from foals born in 2018.

RWITC Stud farms in Maharashtra and Gujarat.

RCTC Stud farms in Gurgaon and Sohna.

HRC Stud farms in Telangana, Ambala, Gothra and Tohana.

BTC Stud farms in Karnataka and Rajasthan (except Ganganagar) and including Mr H. Thambuswamy's place.

MRC Stud farms in Tamilnadu & Uttar Pradesh.

MyRC Stud farms in Punjab and Ganganagar

12. **Other Details**. Veterinary Officers visit to different Breeding Establishments are given in Appendix - B to this Circular. Breeding Establishments are requested to peruse Appendix - B carefully, as it also contains details of the **testing charges** as informed by Chairman, Veterinary Commission, Turf Authorities of India and other useful information.

### <u>SCHEDULE OF EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATION OF FOALS BORN IN 2018</u>

Equine Influenza (EI) vaccination of foals born in 2018 by the breeders/stud farms is absolutely mandatory before they arrive for Annual Sale in Pune or directly into race courses. The following time-bound schedule of three doses of CALVENZA vaccination should be carried out as detailed below:-

1. First EI vaccination : 1<sup>st</sup> week of October 2019

2. Second El vaccination: 1st week of November 2019

3. Third EI vaccination : 1<sup>st</sup> week of December 2019

#### Notes:

- 1. Last EI vaccination should be preferably completed at least TWO weeks before the foals move out of their breeding establishments
- 2. Date of each vaccination, batch number of the vaccine and vaccine sticker should be pasted on the Passport of respective foals. Vaccination is strictly time-bound and every effort should be made to adhere to the above guidelines.
- 3. No foal shall be allowed to enter Annual sale or any race course premises without a complete course of vaccination and proper vaccination records.

#### **COGGINS AND GLANDERS TESTING - FOALS OF 2018**

- 1. All foals of 2018 that desire to enter a racing center at any time should initially have their blood samples drawn by the Veterinary Officer of a Turf Authority and tested by the Diagnostic Research Laboratory, situated in RWITC Ltd, Pune. Samples drawn by other person/s and tests conducted at other laboratories thereon shall not be accepted by Turf Authorities of India.
- 2. To undertake mandatory testing of Two-year olds, the Veterinary Officers will be visiting breeding establishments in Jan 2020. The exact schedule will be informed by the concerned Turf Authorities. The programme of visit of Veterinary Officers is dependent on flight schedules and availability of reservation and is likely to change at short notice. The Veterinary Officers will forward their itinerary directly to the breeding establishment(s) concerned.
- 3. If a breeding establishment / person fails to have all its foals of 2018 sampled in this period for any reason whatsoever including the reason that the foal will go to a racing center more than 4 months later, etc, such breeding establishment/person shall at that time be required to request a Turf Authority to specifically send a Veterinary Officer for drawing the sample. The breeding establishment/person concerned would then have to mandatorily meet an additional expenditure of Rs. 30,000/- representing the additional cost for drawing samples at a later date at any given breeding establishment.
- 4. A supplementary reference set of Laboratory reports of all 2018 born foals, whose blood samples were collected by the Official Veterinarians and tested by Diagnostic Research Laboratories (DRL) Pune, will be made available by 1st March 2020 to all the Sr. Veterinary Officers of race clubs for their verification/confirmation of this mandatory compliance whenever a horse is seeking entry to race course anytime later during 2020.
- 5. NO 2018 born foal shall be allowed into a race course if it was not initially sampled by the Official Vets and tested only at the DRL, Pune. For further clarification on this issue, The Technical Director DRL, Pune or The Chairman, Veterinary Commission, Madras Race Club, Chennai may be approached.
- 6. Breeding establishments are requested to extend their full co-operation to the representative of the Turf Authority by keeping the yearlings ready for sample collection and also ensure that their Passports are available for identification. In case Passports are not available, the Certificate of Identity should be presented.
- 7. A representative of the breeding establishment must be present at the time of collection of the samples. Movements of yearlings should be avoided till the samples are collected.
- 8. No foal of 2018 will be accepted at any Racing Centre either for Auction Sales or for Racing unless their samples are drawn by a Veterinary Officer of a Turf Authority and they are negative for EIA and Glanders. The results of the test will be intimated to the breeding establishment directly by the Sr. Veterinary Officer concerned.
- 9. All breeding establishments are requested to handover a Demand Draft of Rs. 1,000/- per sample being sample collection charges to the concerned Veterinary Officer, who collects the samples.
- 10. The Veterinary Officers need to handover all the samples to Diagnostic Research Laboratory, RWITC Ltd, Pune by 10<sup>th</sup> Jan 2020 for EIA and Glanders testing.
- 11. The Diagnostic Research Laboratory, RWITC Ltd, Pune conducts the tests and forwards the results of EIA and Glanders to the Senior / Chief Veterinary Officers of the Turf Authorities by 20<sup>th</sup> Jan 2020.

- 12. The last date for receipt of repeat samples is 15 th Jan 2020 and the results of the repeat samples or other samples situations, shall be released before 20 Jan 2020.
- 13. The Laboratory testing charges for EIA and Glanders is Rs. 600/- per sample. The Diagnostic Research Laboratory, RWITC, Pune will be conducting the tests at their Lab in Pune.
- 14. The Stud Farms are requested to note that all matters pertaining to service charges and the results of the test are addressed ONLY to the concerned Turf Authority,
